Chemical, Oil & Water Repellent Finishes

For outstanding performance in combined chemical splash protection and water repellency we use Splashgard C6 technology - a fluorocarbon treatment applied to the fabric to provide excellent levels of resistance against oil, water and some chemicals.

When liquid spills come into contact with the fabric, they form into beads and roll off the surface. Any dry soiling is easily brushed off the material.

Moisture Management Finish

Moisture management finish confers wash-resistant hydrophilic properties for fibres of all kinds. The fabrics dry quicker, wick moisture away from the skin and stay soft and breathable even when the wearer is involved in high-intensity activities.

Crease Resistant Finish

This finish delivers two distinctive benefits by combining exceptional crease resistance with controlled shrinkage, resulting in an easy-care fabric for garments that stay looking smart.

Anti mosquito Finish

Vector protection Actigard® finish has long-lasting active ingredients that have proved highly effective against vectors such as mosquitoes and ticks.

Its outstanding durability and enduring effectiveness through high numbers of washes have made this finish an important specification in applications such as military uniforms, bedding, mattresses and floor coverings.

It also conforms to Standard 100 by OEKO-TEX®.

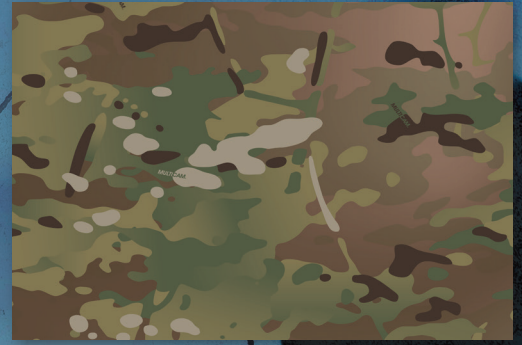

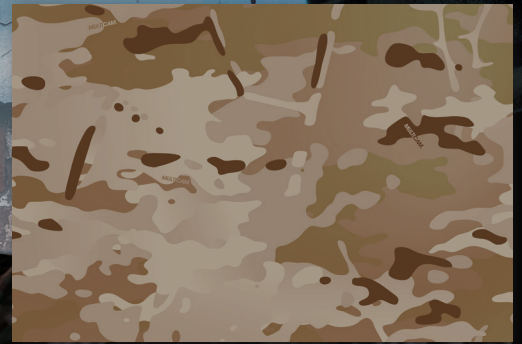

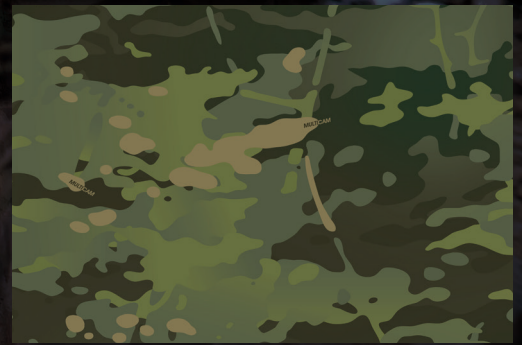

MULTICAM® ARID™ PATTERN

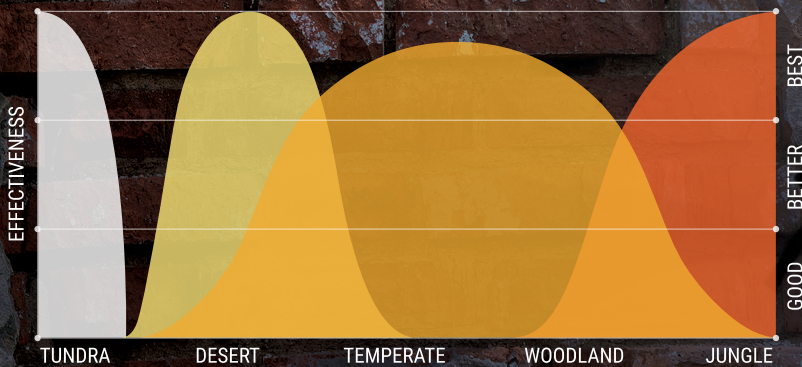

DYED ONLY

This is the perfect solution to a standard defence garment where camouflage isn't required. Carrington Textiles produces over 30 million metres of dyed only fabrics per year and can offer a huge range of shades and substrates to meet your needs. A large amount of the dyed only fabrics that we produce are industrially launderable and have excellent colour fastness, abrasion and strength properties.



Hudson 200

65% polyester / 35% cotton
210gsm, Plain with ripstop

A lightweight, hardwearing fabric for use in trousers, jackets and shirts. It incorporates a ripstop in the weave for technical and aesthetic properties.



DYE AND PRINT

Many camouflage solutions on the market today utilise dye and print technology, this is where the fabric is dyed first and then a design is printed on top of the base dye to produce an effective camouflage. This technique is mainly used to help with print registration and achieve IRR values to ensure the fabric meets all technical specifications.



Cooltex 3

50% cotton / 50% polyester
275gsm, 4/1 satin

Constructed in a way where the inside of the fabric worn next to the skin is predominantly cotton and the outside is predominantly polyester. This therefore combines the comfort of cotton with the hardwearing properties of polyester.





PRINT ONLY

Various camouflage designs today can utilise a print only option. This alternative helps on costs and means that smaller minimum order quantities can be used as the fabric doesn't need to go through as many processes as dye and print.



Troy

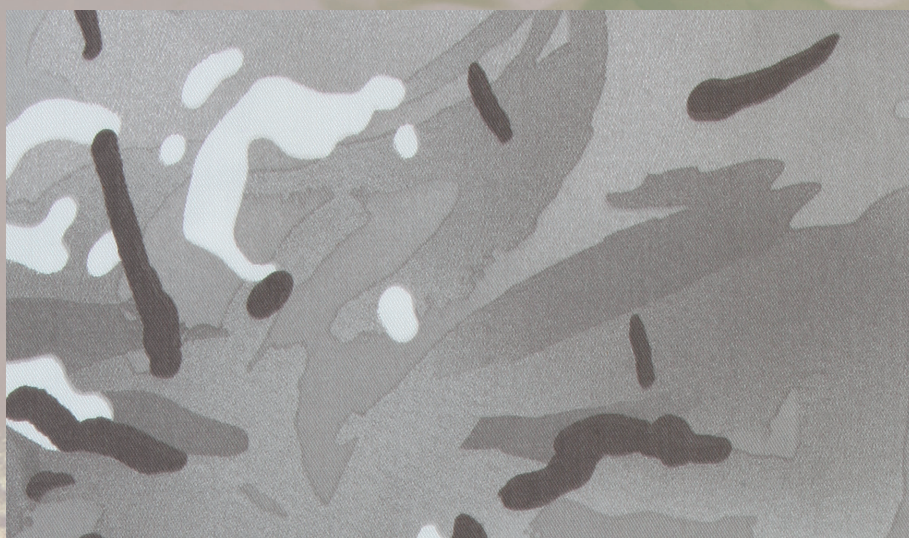
60% cotton / 40% polyester

WATERPROOF
